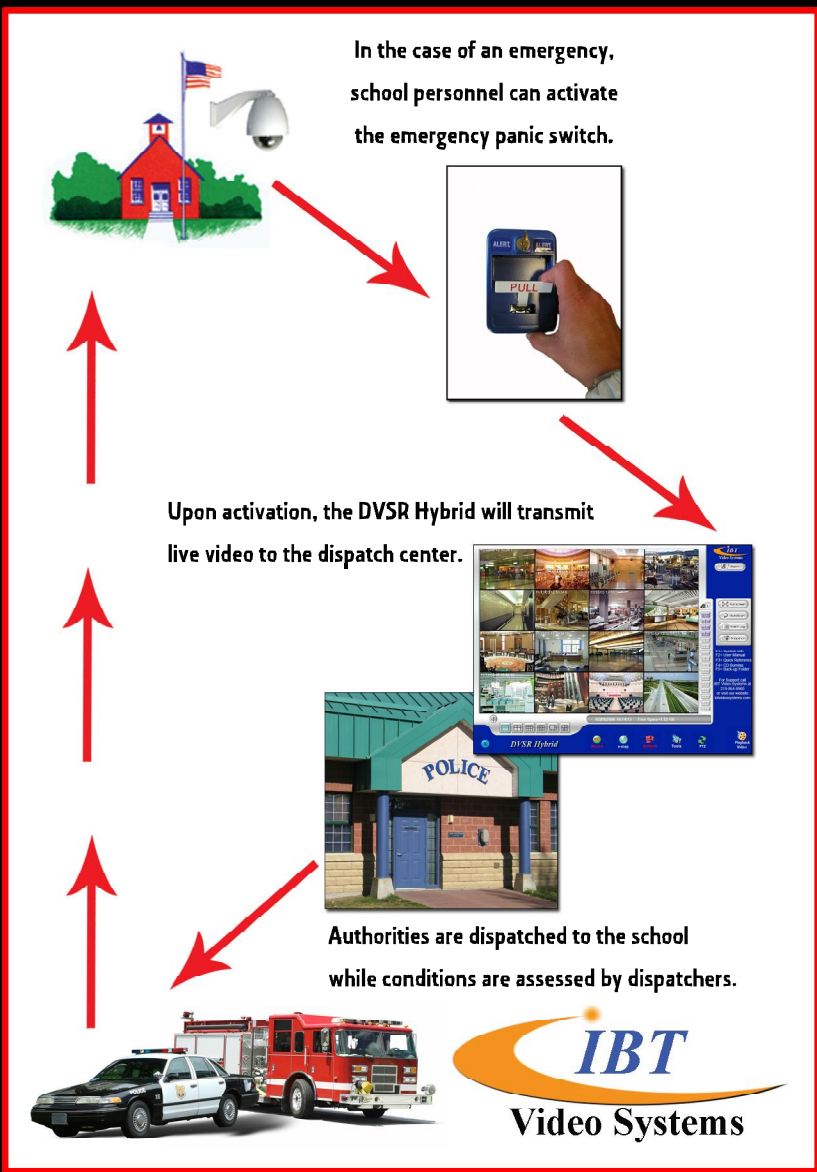

Red Lake High School Massacre
Monday, March 21, 2005

Jeffrey Weise, a student at Red Lake High School in Red Lake, Beltrami County, Minnesota, killed seven people including a teacher and a security guard and wounded seven others.
